Re: Recreation and Community Facilities and Amenities Scheme, 2007.

A Chara,

Further to the decision of South Tipperary Co Council on 1st December, 2003 and the priorities set for the 2007 Scheme by the Council on 4th December, 2006, this Scheme was advertised in the Nationalist of the 6th January, 2007, closing on the 2rd April.

1. Of the fifty-four applications, fifty have received grant approval from the Assessment Committee (list in Appendix 1), having either provided sufficient information to allow assessment or on the basis that they provide some information before contract signing.
2. All will have to provide standard documentation (e.g. tax certificates) and some more than that, before payment.
3. Grants are given on the basis that they may be reviewed if the project receives additional funds from other sources.
4. A small number of grants (six) have been given to applicants who have applied to town councils only on the basis that their projects have a benefit to those living in the adjacent county areas.
5. A small number of applicants (four) have not been recommended for grants on the basis that their projects are not, as yet, sufficiently developed. These files will be reviewed later in the year if there is sufficient finance and if the required data is provided.
6. Two applications from 2006 and one from 2005 have been advanced sufficiently to be included in the list of recommended grants.
7. There are also two other applications from within the Council,
Environmental works in Cahir and a
Civil Defence County Emergency Catering Kitchen.
These have been included on the lists below.

These sixty-one proposed grants (fifty from 2007, two from 2006, one from 2005, six to town projects, and two to council projects) have a total grant figure of €2,184,760. This amount, added to the €4,983,477 already granted in 2003-2006, will make a total of €7,168,237 granted under the Scheme in five years.

Grants

The proposed grants are being recommended in the context of the 2007 Priorities, as agreed by Council, which are dedicated youth facilities, playgrounds, community facilities in communities experiencing unprecedented growth and then all other projects, having regard also to Council projects.

Major Grant of up to €100,000 for

Area projects having an impact/importance in an electoral area

Large playgrounds

New or 'start-up' large community-based multi-use projects in villages experiencing sudden and unprecedented growth

Community Grant of up to €40,000 for

projects having an impact/importance to a community

Local Grant of between €10,000 and €20,000 for smaller sport/local projects

A letter of notification will be sent to the projects as soon as possible. It is hoped to hold a general briefing meeting for the successful applicants on Thursday 13st September at 7.30 pm in the Council Chamber to brief the grantees and to give them their contracts. The contracts will include details of any remaining documentation or data required.

The 2007 priorities have been addressed with the funding of youth facilities in Tipperary , Cashel , Fethard, and Killenaule, playgrounds in Donohill, Clerihan (ground works) and Annacarthy, and community facilities in locations experiencing unprecedented growth (Clerihan and Kilsheelan) as well as many other projects.
