Fingal County Council

“That this Council calls on the Government to reverse the massive cuts in education introduced in the Budget and also the increase in class sizes/reduction of teachers and that should this motion be passed by Fingal County Council that we would request all other Local Authorities to follow suit”.

Fingal County Council

“That this Council condemns outright the proposed Government cutbacks in education and, in particular, their potentially devastating effects on schools within Fingal. These cuts in teaching posts and resources will lower the quality of education and exacerbate disadvantage and inequality. This Council calls for the withdrawal of these cuts which target children for a financial crisis not of their making”.
