"That we call on the Minister for Education to reverse the cuts to the Higher Education Grants Scheme, as they are placing huge hardship on students and their parents". 01/02/11

"I propose that this Council contact the NRA to have the roundabout at Kedrah renamed "Kedrah Roundabout". This will create less confusion than having a number of roundabouts called "New Inn Road Roundabout" within a short distance of New Inn". 07/02/11
