COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT SCHEME TO IMPROVE LOCAL (COUNTY) ROADS WHICH ARE IN CHARGE TO SOUTH TIPPERARY COUNTY COUNCIL

South Tipperary County Council is inviting local resident groups to apply for inclusion in a scheme to improve local (County) roads on which the Council is not in a position to carry out regular maintenance works, e.g. low traffic volume, minor roads, cul-de-sacs etc.

The emphasis of the scheme will be on the local groups carrying out preparatory works, e.g. drainage, restoration, hedge cutting, and the Council thereafter improving the roads in question by way of pothole repairs/surface dressing.

The works contributed by the local residents should include the following: -

- 1) Open drainage, both in adjoining lands and where same runs alongside the road.
- 2) Pipe drainage under gateways.
- 3) Provision of lay-bys on very narrow roads.
- 4) Removal of overhanging branches to provide a minimum clear height of 25 ft above road surface and cut hedges.
- 5) Removal of grass banks to aid road drainage.
- 6) Removal of hedges for sight distance improvement and erection of concrete post and rail fence.
- 7) Fill potholes with materials provided by the County Council (cul-de-sacs only).

All other works relating to piping of drainage or road surface, pavement repairs, to be carried out by the Local Authority.

The Area Engineer will direct the local residents in regard to the work he considers appropriate for them to carry out. Furthermore, this work will be supervised through the Area Engineer's staff. Any work being carried out will have to be carried out during the normal County Council working hours except by prior agreement of the Council.

It is acceptable for applicants to pay at least 15% of the cost of the scheme, in advance, in lieu of works.

The scheme will operate in the following manner: -

- 1) Application will be made to the Council by way of application form. Whether or not a scheme proceeds will be at the discretion of the Council.
- 2) Where a proposed scheme is accepted, the Area Engineer will brief the representative of the residents with regard to the work required.
- 3) The representative will then inform the Area Engineer of the proposed working dates.
- 4) The Area Engineer and his supervisory staff will supervise the work as being carried out by the residents.
- 5) When work has been carried out to the satisfaction of the Area Engineer, the remainder of the works required on the road including piping of drainage and strengthening/reshaping and grouting will be undertaken in the normal manner by the County Council.

In the operation of the above, the Area Engineer will allow no longer than one month for the carrying out of the works as required. Failure to commence and make a bona fide substantial effort on the scheme within one month will eliminate a road from consideration.

Please note that this Scheme is limited to the most cost-effective proposals submitted.
